WASHINGTON, DC (April 20, 2022) – The [Paper and Packaging Board](#) (P+PB) is seeking nominees for three open board seats in the following regions: two from the South for a three-year term and one from the rest of the U.S. for a one-year term. The board term begins on January 1, 2023.

Nominations start April 20, 2022, and run through May 20, 2022. All nominations are submitted to USDA and the Secretary of Agriculture appoints new board members by the end of 2022.
